Cucurbits, Peaches or other sulphur sensitive plants.

MIXING: Shake contents well before using. Add the required amount of
product to the water in the spray tank with stirring or agitation. Agitate
while spraying. DO NOT mix the product with acidic water of pH below 4.

APPLICATION: Spray in the cool of the day. The spray mixture should be
used on the same day it is mixed with water. DO NOT apply when freezing
weather is predicted or the air temperature is over 32°C. DO NOT apply
product within 2 weeks of an oil spray except a indicated under the
"Compatibility" statement below.

COMPATIBILITY: This product may be mixed with Kendon White Oil for
use on Pome and Stone fruit during the dormant to semi-dormant stages
only. For details of this mixture consult the label for Kendon White Oil.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRESTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT: DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in the closed, original container in a well ventilated area, as cool as possible. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways. desirable vegetation and tree roots.

Empty containers and product should not be burnt.
